Die Nürnberger Gesetze

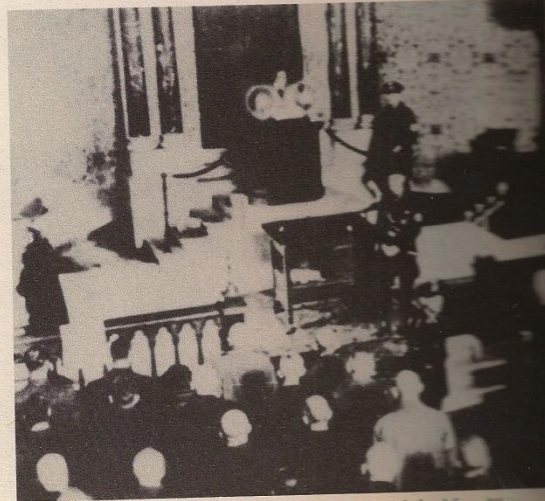

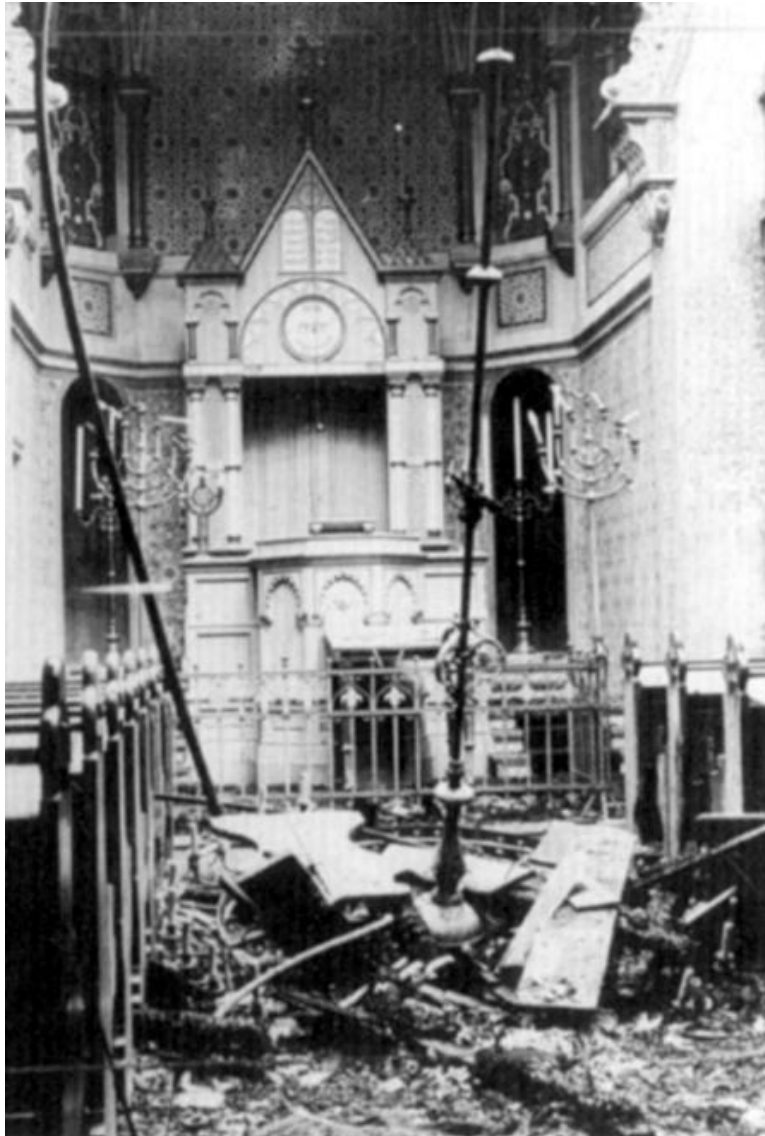

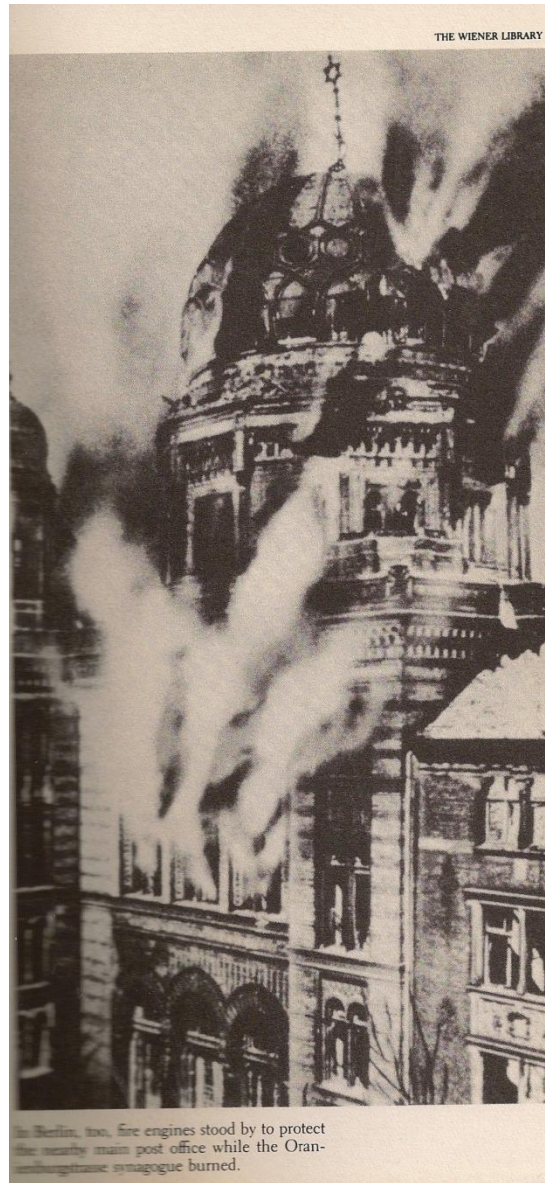

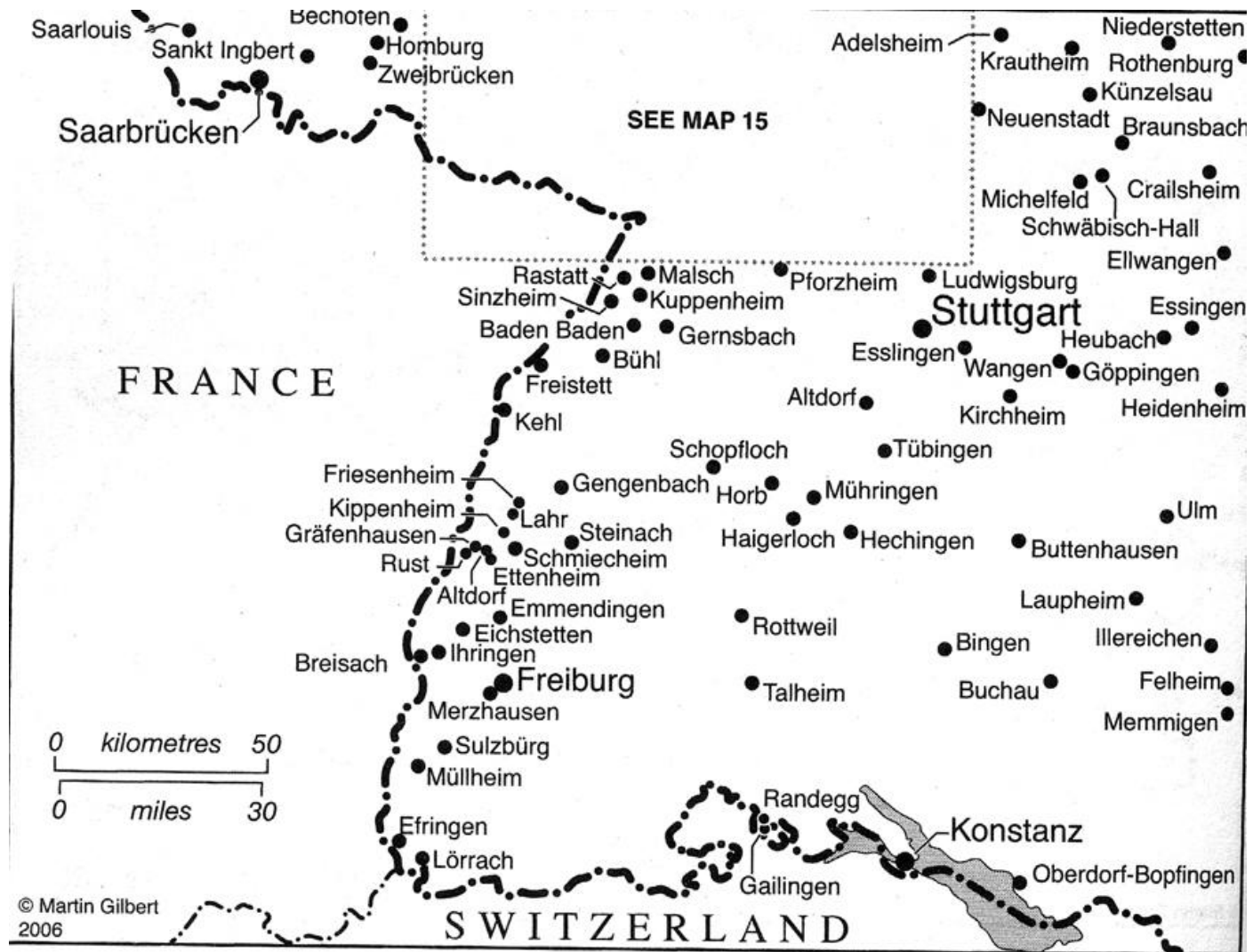

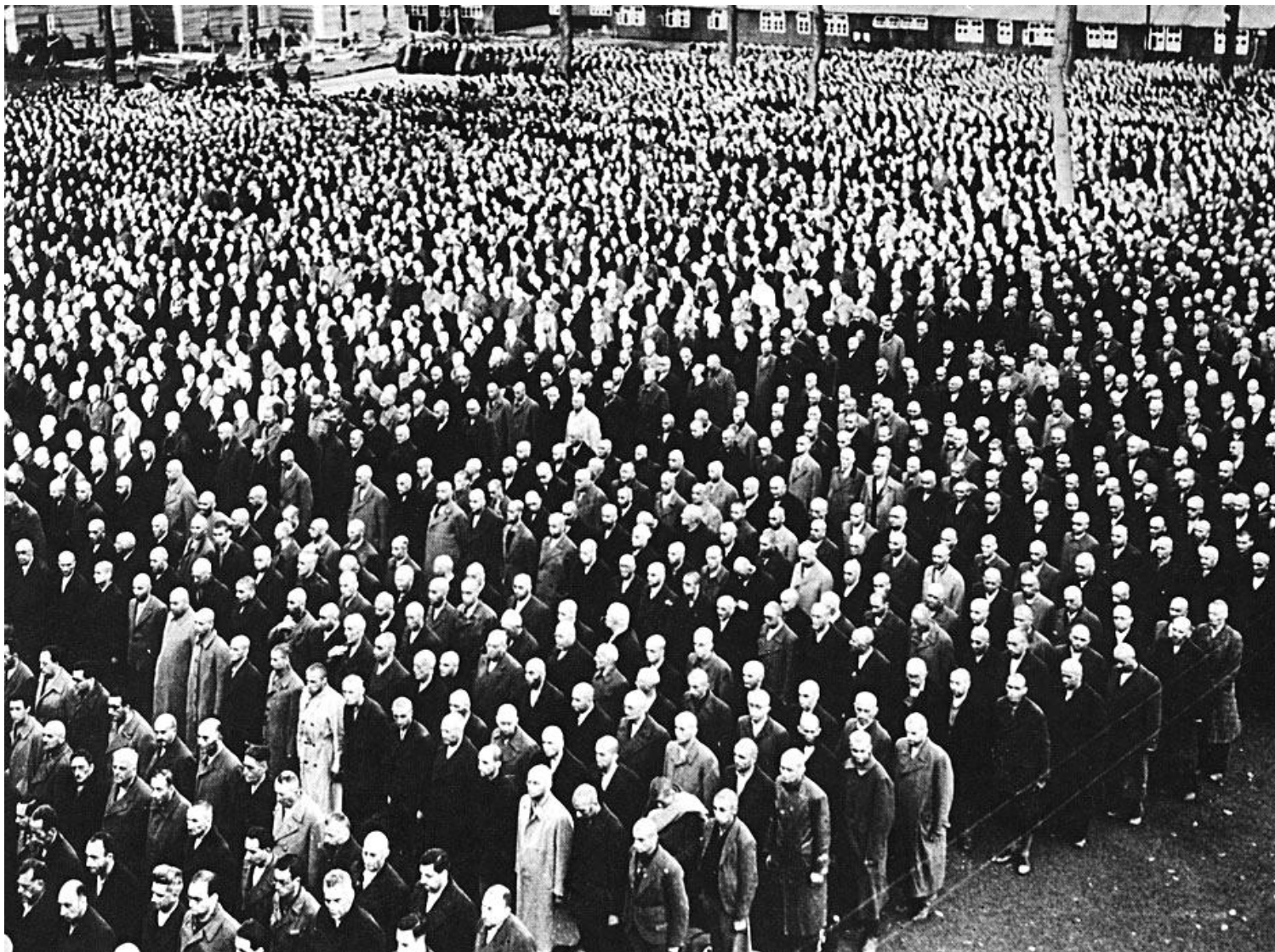

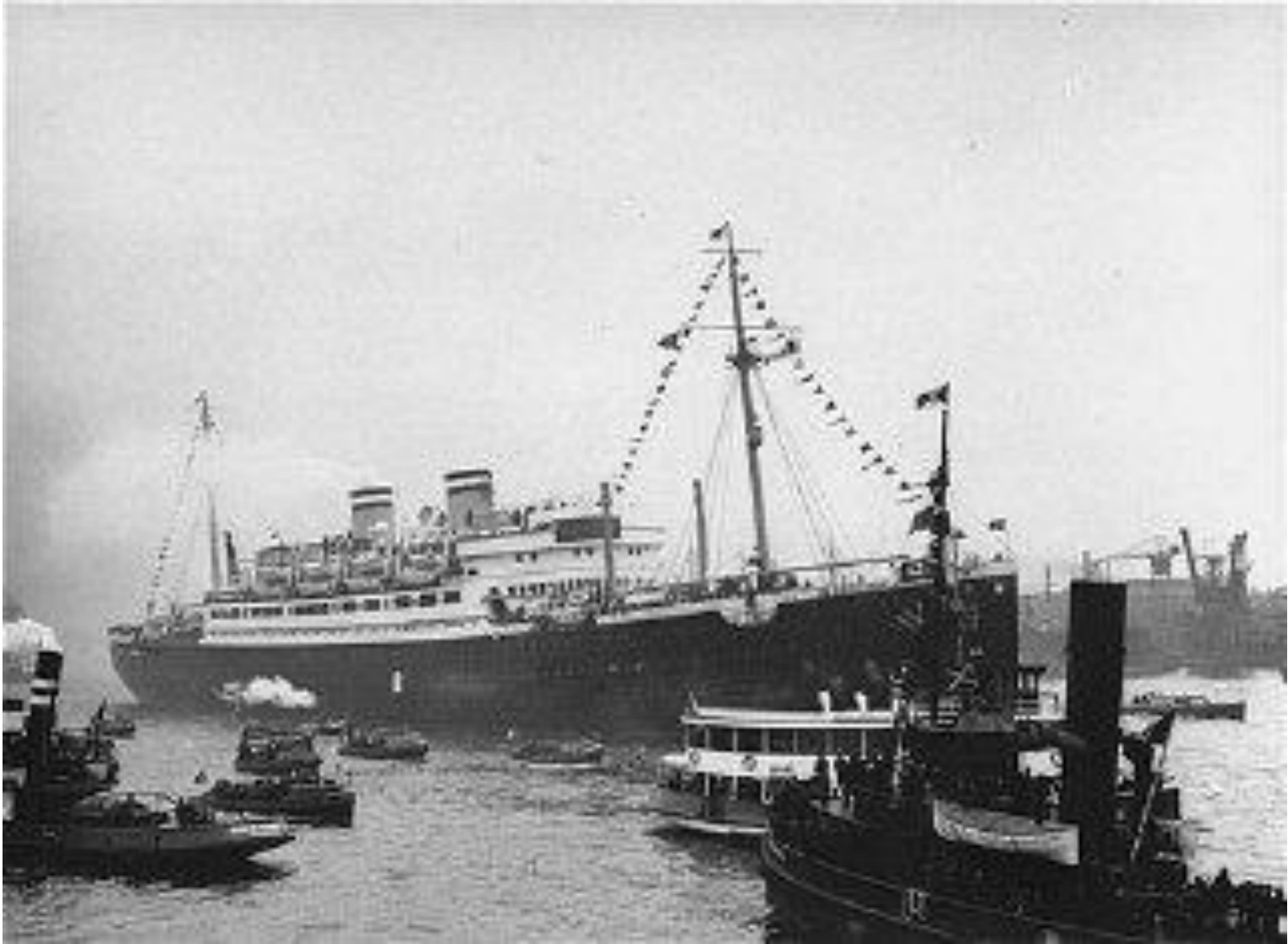

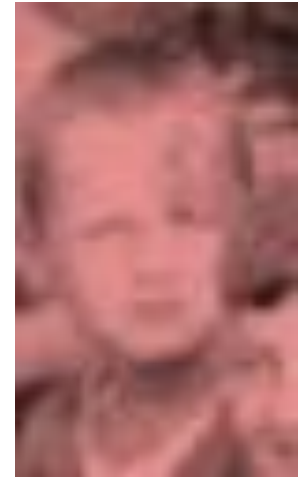

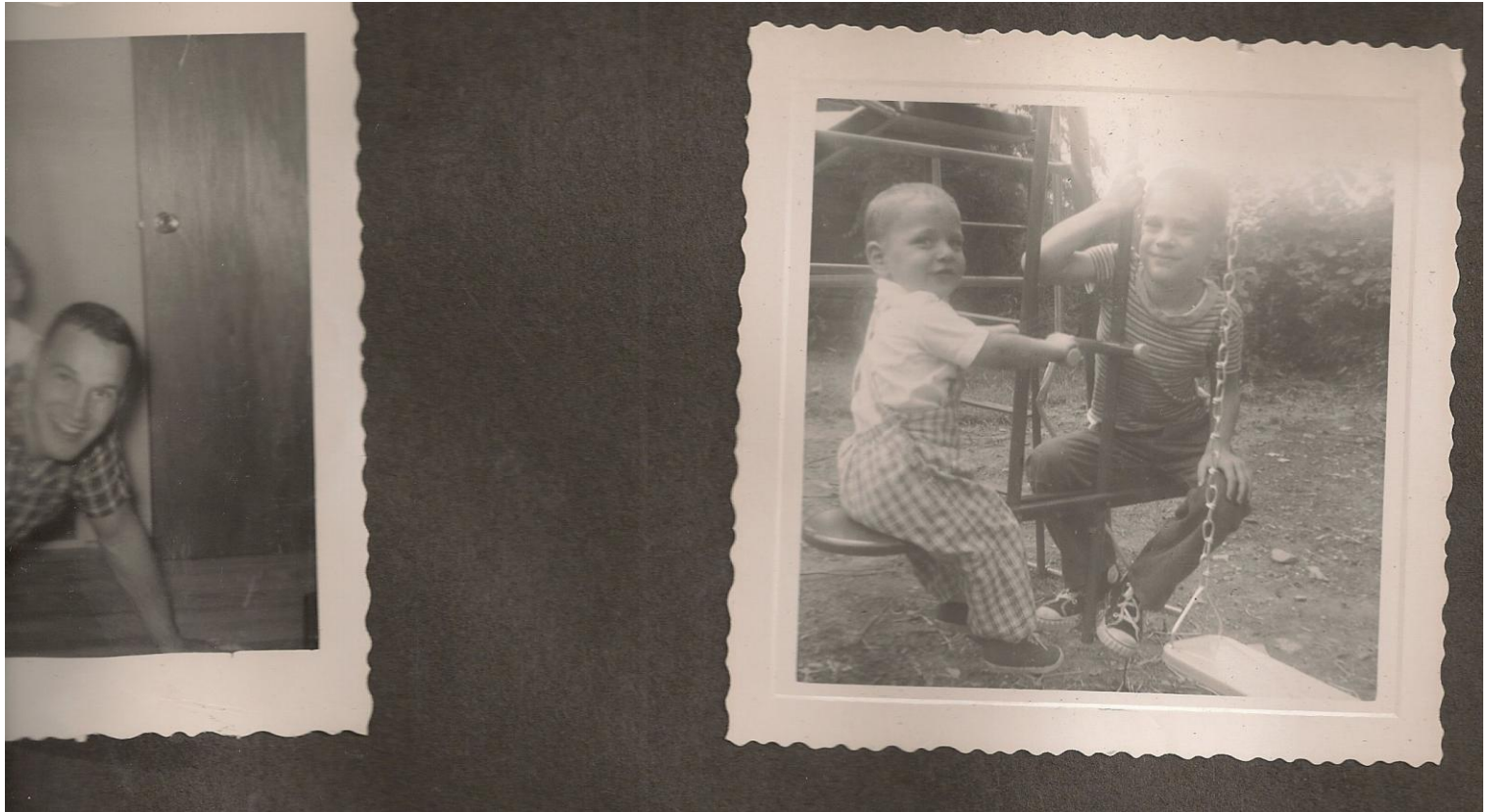
